## Title

Club Coach - Grassroots Recreational (Part-Time)

## Position Summary

Do you have a passion for the development of foundational skills among U4 - U8 soccer players? Do you excel at working with youth ranging from U4 - U18? Are you an excellent communicator and a self-directed organizational guru? If you answered yes, then this opportunity may be for you!

The Club Coach supports the Nanaimo United FC (NUFC) Technical Lead in the development and delivery of the NUFC Technical Program for players and coaches at grassroots recreational levels with a specific focus on U4 - U8 players. They take the lead in the delivery of the Little Kickers program (U4 - U6) and the U7 - U8 programs. They may also support the NUFC academies, extra development sessions, summer sessions, volunteer coaches and various practice sessions throughout the season.

## Key Relationships

- Reports to the NUFC Technical Lead
- Coordinates the Little Kickers program coaches
- Working relationships include the member services coordinator, volunteer coaches and volunteer board members
- Occasionally directs volunteer or other paid session coaches

## Primary Duties

Primary duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assist the Technical Lead in the development and delivery of the NUFC soccer program
- Serve as the primary lead and point of contact for the Little Kickers (U4 - U6) and U7 - U8 programs.
- Play a primary role in communicating with players, parents and coaches.
- Support the design and delivery of the NUFC coaching syllabus
- Support the Technical Lead in the delivery of coach education programs and sessions
- Assists the Technical Lead in the delivery of some or all of the NUFC Academies, extra player development sessions and spring & summer sessions.
- Attend meetings with Technical Lead, board members, coaches and parents as and when required
- Assist in the management and organization of all club equipment and uniforms, particularly relating to the U4 - U8 Grassroots Recreational groups.

## Required Certification and Experience

- Minimum 3 years coaching experience
- Preferred BC Soccer Pre B / C License or higher
- Expectation of ongoing coaching professional development

## Requirements

- Current (within last 3 years) criminal record check
- Access to your own transportation

## Salary, Work Schedule and Term

- \$16,000 - \$30,000 (based on experience) per year assuming an average of 20 hours per week. Exact schedule to be determined by the Technical Lead and will vary depending on season. Most work is during evenings and on weekends
- Position to start in Feb 2019 and run to July 31, 2020 with possibility of annual renewal.
